On July, 25, Winston's Dallas office participated in a pro bono legal aid clinic run by the <u>Dallas Volunteer Attorney</u> <u>Program</u> (DVAP), an organization that trains and supports volunteer attorneys to provide free legal assistance to low-income individuals. During the clinic, Winston attorneys and summer associates gathered information and provided advice to more than 40 people at or below the federal poverty line. The cases involved landlord tenant issues, tax-related issues, custody battles, probate questions, expunctions, divorce proceedings, and more.
