Abbe served as Chief Minority Counsel to the House of Representatives during the impeachment proceedings against President Bill Clinton. His recent representations include United States Senator of New Jersey Robert Menendez, Audi CEO Rupert Stadler, and Senior White House Adviser Jared Kushner.
