As part of the conference, Susan also spoke on October 29 at the Healthcare Reform & Trumpcare Summit on the topic of "Potential ACA Reform Efforts Post 2018 Election." The summit addressed the current state of the ACA, IRS reporting and penalties, and the effects of changes in federal law on employers in states across the country.
