

On April 15, Winston Paris Corporate Chair <u>Jérôme Herbet</u>, Partner <u>Sara Susnjar</u>, and Associate <u>Annie Maudouit</u> joined technology leaders at the Paris Blockchain Conference hosted by the French Ministry of Economy and Finance during the Paris Blockchain Week Summit.



The event gathered worldwide prominent blockchain actors together with representatives of the French securities and market authority (AMF) and the French government. Three panels were dedicated to blockchain's impact on the global economic order, opportunities for the financing of companies, and the creation of innovative products and services within the finance community. Panelists all agreed on the need to regulate without "killing innovation."
