She also works with the government through associations to keep partnerships going and to find new trends or ways to track assets. "The public-private partnership is important. The idea is to make the U.S. and global anti-money laundering systems more secure," she said.

As for the future of anti-money laundering, Cari says that the legal landscape has evolved. "It's a more complicated world because a lot of it is now in the virtual space. There will be increased sophistication in money laundering with the youth of digital currencies and blockchain to engage in those acts, as well as supply chain transparency."
