At Washington University School of Law's 1L Employer Showcase on January 16, Partner <u>Jim Herbison</u> (WashU '01) and Associate <u>Tom Neuner</u> (WashU '18) hosted a small group discussion where they offered the following tips to help students make the most of their 1L summer:

- There are a wide variety of jobs available law firm, government, clerkship, public interest, teaching assistant but it is essential that you work somewhere over the summer. It will be the first bullet point on your resume, and potential employers are likely to ask about it in interviews.
- If geographic location is important to you, then make that a priority when searching for summer jobs. It can be difficult to convince an employer that you want to be in a certain location if you have never lived there.
- Try to find the best fit. Assess your interests and the skills/experience you want to develop. You are interviewing your potential employer as much as they are interviewing you.
- **Be a positive presence at your summer job** and come eager to work and learn. First impressions can carry you a long way, and you never know when you'll need a reference or recommendation.
- Take advantage of your network, and be sure to reach out to alums at firms that you are interested in learning about.
