This annual report highlights star litigators who scored significant victories on behalf of their clients in high-stakes matters and the attorney's track record over her/his career.

Jeffrey is recognized for his work with the athlete classes in *Alston v. NCAA*, the antitrust class action challenge against NCAA rules restricting conferences/schools from compensating athletes for the multibillion-dollar revenue streams they generate.

Abbe is recognized for achieving final acquittal for former Puerto Rico State Sen. Hector Martinez after nine years—including two jury trials, three circuit appeals, and a U.S. Supreme Court decision—by following a "fight-for-every-inch-of-the-battlefield" strategy.
