

The Rising Tide of Antitrust Investigations and Lawsuits Against Apple: App Developers May See a Wave of Changes

Big Tech is caught in the undertow of a growing number of antitrust battles domestically and abroad. Apple is getting pressed on its App Store policies by the U.S. Department of Justice, state attorneys general, the European Commission, and in private civil litigation. The House Judiciary's antitrust subcommittee recently grilled Big Tech CEOs in hearings that dove deep into allegations of antitrust misconduct.
