Peter Crowther Discusses FIFA's European Super League Ban Threat with GlobalData Sport

Can FIFA legally stop football players from competing in the World Cup if the planned European Super League goes ahead?

Winston & Strawn Partner Peter Crowther shared his thoughts with GlobalData Sport on the controversial issue, stating that FIFA is engaging in anti-competitive behaviour and is "abusing a dominant position by moving to effectively shut down a competitor."

Peter added that FIFA's threat to stop players from competing in the World Cup is not a proportionate response, as the proposed restrictions have nothing to do with the competitive threat, and that if it was a normal marketplace, FIFA would have to offer some type of commercial incentive for clubs and players to stay with it.
