China has not only opened courts in Beijing, Xi’an, and Shenzhen for this purpose, but it has also spearheaded the China Africa Joint Arbitration Centre in Johannesburg. While this shows China’s preparedness for such disputes, what—if anything—has Africa done to prepare for them? This panel will discuss the opportunities presented to Africa by the BRI and how arbitration institutions in African countries can ensure that they are better placed to resolve such disputes.
