

Peter Crowther Cited as Positive Force in Professional Footballers' Association Reform

Former Professional Footballers' Association (PFA) Chairman Ben Purkiss was recently interviewed in *The Times* about his fight to renew the PFA's focus on players' rights, mental health, and anti-discrimination practices. While he was not initially met with a surge of support, Ben was victorious in achieving his goals and ousting the long-ruling chief executive from whom many of the organization's core issues stemmed.

Ben cited Winston & Strawn London Managing Partner Peter Crowther as an ally during the legal battle:

"There has been really strong resistance to the changes that were recommended by the review, at every single state," [Ben] says. "Crucially we had a lawyer in Peter Crowther, a man of real integrity, who was able to support us too."
