

Jeffrey Kessler Speaks on College Athletics in the Supreme Court at ABTL Program

Jeffrey has been lead counsel in some of the most complex antitrust, sports law, and intellectual property law cases in the country, including major jury trials, and has represented a number of U.S. and international companies in criminal and civil investigations in the antitrust, sports law, trade, and FCPA areas. He has litigated some of the most famous sports-antitrust cases in history, including *McNeil v. the NFL*, the landmark antitrust jury trial which led to the establishment of free agency in the National Football League (NFL), and *Brady v. NFL*, which led to the end of the 2011 NFL lockout.
