

## The SBA Increases SBIC Licensing and Examination Fees

AUGUST 31, 2022

The U.S. Small Business Administration (the “SBA”) has announced that licensing and examination fees charged to a Small Business Investment Company (“SBIC”) or SBIC license applicant will be increased in accordance with the annual inflation adjustment required under SBIC regulations.

Effective October 1, 2022, the new fees will be as follows:

### LICENSING FEES

<b>Initial Licensing Fee</b> (paid in conjunction with the submission of the Management Assessment Questionnaire)	\$11,500
<b>Final Licensing Fee</b> (paid in conjunction with the submission of the License Application)	\$40,200

### EXAMINATION FEES

<b>Minimum Base Fee</b>	\$10,400
<b>Minimum Base Fee</b> (Non-Leveraged SBICs)	\$34,500

## EXAMINATION FEES

<b>Minimum Base Fee</b> (Leveraged SBICs)	\$50,600
<b>Delay Fee</b>	\$800
