Through a generous donation, Winston & Strawn Dallas office Managing Partner Tom Melsheimer and his wife, Michelle (Miki) Melsheimer, established the Melsheimer Fellows Initiative for the University of Notre Dame's Klau Institute for Civil and Human Rights at the Keough School of Global Affairs. The fellowship will help financially support students pursuing national and international learning opportunities that benefit underrepresented individuals and communities.
