- Analyze and draft agreements to ensure the client owns the Al technologies it purports to own
- Draft and negotiate agreements regarding third party use of client-owned Al technologies
- Develop, negotiate, and execute major contracts that implicate the use, sharing, disclosure, and safeguarding of personal information.

- Draft and negotiate agreements with vendors who wish to use client data to train the vendor's Al technologies
- Draft and negotiate agreements with vendors regarding client use of vendor Al technologies
- Draft policies regarding proper use of third party Al tools by client employees
- Develop, negotiate, and execute major contracts that implicate the use, sharing, disclosure, and safeguarding of personal information
