Winston has signed the Campaign for Greener Arbitrations' (CGA) Green Pledge, an initiative aimed at reducing the carbon footprint of international arbitrations through behavioral changes. The CGA is a global effort to raise awareness of the environmental impact of international arbitration and promote best practices to minimize this impact. The Green Pledge outlines eight guiding principles, including encouraging the use of videoconferencing instead of travel, using electronic submissions and correspondence, and offsetting carbon emissions from arbitration-related travel.
