On March 7, 2014, the Department of Justice issued a <u>press release</u> announcing that Sea Star Line LLC and Horizon Lines LLC have agreed to resolve claims that they violated the False Claims Act by fixing the price of governmentimpelled cargoes in the U.S.-Puerto Rico trade. Under the settlement agreements, Sea Star and Horizon agreed to pay \$1.9 million and \$1.5 million, respectively. The settlement is the latest chapter in Government's multiyear investigation into price-fixing in the trade, and underscores the additional exposure faced by Federal contractors in price-fixing cases.

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
