- Represented Health insurer in breach of contract and fraud action in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan.
- Represented a leading precision oncology company against a competitor for false advertising and unfair competition under the Lanham Act. After a 3-week trial, a jury unanimously awarded our client a \$292.5 million verdict, including \$175.5 million in punitive damages, representing one of the largest Lanham Act false advertising verdicts ever rendered. The jury also unanimously rejected the defendant's counterclaims.
