The Coast Guard issued a request for comments to be published in the Federal Register on January 19, 2012 regarding its policies and procedures for the inspection of U.S. flag vessels enrolled in the <u>Maritime Security Program</u>. The proposed guidance would detail the Coast Guard's process for issuing a Certificate of Inspection to MSP vessels for the first time. The draft circular proposes to establish a "comprehensive approach" to the MSP inspection process, which would include a two-level approach composed of "MSP (Regular)" and "MSP Select." MSP (Regular) would apply traditional inspection methods to newly reflagged vessels, whereas MSP Select would entail a less stringent level of oversight for vessels that have an established history of satisfactory compliance and performance.
