- Use of predictive coding
- Different pricing models to consider
- Right-sourcing e-discovery for corporations of varying sizes and litigation profiles
- Developing a modern litigation response program.
- Recent trends in centralized discovery and national counsel programs.
- Early Data Assessment/Early Case Assessment as a means to control costs.
