Washington, D.C. associate **Maria Kostytska** was a panelist at the 74th Conference of the International Law Association (ILA) hosted by the Netherlands Society of International Law on Tuesday, August 17 in the Hague.

Ms. Kostytska presented on the topic of “Invoking Human Rights Standards and Precedents in Investment Arbitration” as part of the session “Integrating Human Rights in Civil Cases.” The session was divided into two panels – the plaintiffs’ and the defendants’ – and featured experts from across the globe who addressed the interplay between human rights and civil law.
