

Charlie Papavizas Speaks at Offshore Wind Finance Forum

Maritime & Admiralty Practice Chair Charlie Papavizas moderated a panel at the Offshore Wind Finance Forum hosted by the Business Network for Offshore Wind and Société Générale on April 3 in New York.

The panel, titled “Equity Investments in the Offshore Wind (OSW) Sector,” examined investment opportunities during development, construction, and operation. Panelists explored the following questions:

- Development Stage equity – What role can institutional investors play in partnering with developers? How early are investors willing and able to invest? Do developers need the Project to have a lease? An off take agreement?
- FID Equity – How do offshore wind projects investment opportunities align with hurdle rates and risk profiles of traditional infrastructure fund investors? Are investors willing to commit prior to FID?
- Other Opportunities?
- What are the largest challenges the regional industry faces investing in the region?
