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Nothing quite beats the exhilarating work involved in a merger or strategic acquisition. From the late nights of strategic discussions to the grueling exercise of due diligence, business interests must be balanced with vital legal decisions. Chief among them are considerations related to the <u>privacy</u> and cybersecurity issues practices of the target entity. This article highlights issues that typically arise during corporate transactions, and may serve as a starting point for thinking through privacy due diligence.

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
