

The firm's <u>Chicago office</u> was the site for the second meeting of "It's Just [Black Lawyers Having] Lunch," an initiative led by Associate <u>Chris Wilson</u> and two other Chicago attorneys, which aims to provide a platform for growing and strengthening the network of black attorneys in the city.

More than 100 black attorneys attended the lunch on March 28, which featured opening remarks from Winston Black Lawyers Network (BLN) affinity group co-chair <u>Sam Mendenhall</u>.
