

On July 27, a team from our London office took part in the <u>Diamond Relays 2015</u> at the Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park. The brand-new event comprised a 5x5k road relay around one loop of the iconic park.

Over 1,000 runners took to the course, which incorporated landmarks such as the Orbit Tower and the Aquatics Centre, before finishing in the Olympic Stadium.
